Introduction

The Taranaki Review was established by the Govett-Brewster Art Gallery to survey the work of local artists.

As a selected exhibition the Review has been a constant source of lively and often passionate debate since its beginnings in the 1970s.

The selection panel appointed by the Gallery each year is composed of people with a wide knowledge of the arts. In some years panelists have come from outside the region. In the last three years panel members have been local people, chosen because of their interest not only in the art of Taranaki but also in the wider field of contemporary art.

This year has seen the introduction of new selection procedures, which encouraged artists to submit up to six works (formerly two.) This has allowed for a far wider range of each artist's work to be considered than was the case in previous years.

The three selectors were **Doreen Bridgeman** of New Plymouth, an experienced art watcher; Fine Arts graduate Marie Horner from Kaponga, and Clive Cullen, an architect and director of Hawera's Gallery 79.

The selectors initially considered artists' documentation in the form of drawings, photographs or written proposals. This selection method, which has not previously been used for this exhibition, is a common procedure in exhibitions where large numbers of works are being assessed.

The final selection was made from viewing the works chosen in the first round. From an initial total of 465 submissions, this year's Review comprises 154 works by 87 artists.

The Gallery staff hope you enjoy the exhibition.

The Review is dead, long live the Review ... Vive la difference!

The Taranaki Review has changed; it is no longer a competition that decides who best reflects us.

There are no rankings, no compulsory acquisition or prizes worth more than the value placed on the work by the winning artist.

Changes to the Review have been like good storytelling. They've begun at the beginning with hours of pre-selection from photographs, slides, video or working drawings, which did not produce the horrific distortions several artists had worried about.

Yes, scale was a surprise! Some works were smaller than expected, some larger. Some had more impact when seen, others less, but wonderfully, most works had the impact hoped for.

Of more concern should be the shrinking range of media submitted. There was little woodware, less textile work and no glass, all areas where I believe local artists to be very fine indeed.

A Victorian, Margaret Hungerford, wrote: Beauty is in the eye of the beholder. Ugliness is also in our perception.

So, works exhibited here will puzzle, provoke and please you. More will mystify, anger, amuse and delight you. As it should be.

However you react, and you will, you are ultimately reacting to those around you.

Aren't they amazing? Such a range of people of varying ages, occupations, creative perceptions, techniques and intensities. They feel a far greater affinity with form, colour and texture than many of us who increasingly expect the electronic media to provide us with our daily colour.

Their different perceptions are here for you to think on.
